Dear Vehicle Owner

This letter is to inform you that the Parish Council will be undertaking a planned (planning approved) restoration of the War Memorial (and immediate area) with works beginning on the **5th July 2021**.

To facilitate the contractors and upgrade works, the Parish Council car park on the map below will be **closed from Monday the 5th July 2021 at 10:00AM to the 1st September 2021 at 10:00AM.**

The Parish Council would kindly request that any vehicle (that you own) parked on the car park be relocated to the alternate parking site at the Village Hall which is being made available during the closure.



What do I need to do to support the Parish Council with the planned restoration?

1. Contact the Parish Council via one of the methods below to be provided with a car parking permit that allows *free parking* at the Village Hall throughout the car park closure.

2. Please relocate any vehicle that you park by the War Memorial on the car park highlighted to the alternate parking provided at the Village Hall on Shropshire Brook Road.
3. Display the parking permit in your vehicle windscreen whilst parked at the Village Hall.
